CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CHILDREN / YOUNG PLAYERS **NEUFC – CC01**

Children/young players are expected to:

- Keep within the defined boundary of the playing/coaching area
- Behave and listen to all instructions from the manager/coach
- Take care of equipment owned by the Club
- Refrain from the use of bad language or racial/sectarian references
- Refrain from bullying or persistent use of rough and dangerous play
- Show respect to other players, coaches and parents/guardians
- Report abuse / inappropriate behaviour
- Play fairly
- Respect officials and accept decisions
- Be gracious in defeat
- Respect opponents and not cheat
- Not use violence
- Refrain from sulking

Children/young people have the right to:

- Be safe and listened to
- Be respected
- Privacy
- Enjoy football in a protective environment
- Be referred to professional help if needed
- Be protected from inappropriate behaviour/abuse by other club members

- Participate on an equal basis, appropriate to their ability
- Experience competition and the desire to win
- Be believed when asking for help.
